### **Telephone numbers**

031-8889-4736    797-463-777    713-894-123    999-234-112

### **Sharing telephone numbers**

Steven: Hello, what's your name?

Lucas: Hi. I'm Lucas. What's your name?

Steven: Steven. Can we just check whether I have your correct telephone number?

Lucas: Certainly.

Steven: Is it **031-8889-4736?**

Lucas: No, my phone number is **031-8898-4736.**

Steven: **031-8898-4736.** Thank you.

Students can move around in class and ask different students for their telephone numbers. Pronunciation of the numbers is important.

## Confusing numbers

Practice the pronunciation of numbers ending in “teen” and “ty”.

Numbers ending on “teen” have the stress on the second part of the word. Numbers ending on “ty” have the stress on the first part of the word.

### Examples:

thirteen

thirty

sixteen

sixty

fifteen

fifty
