On our way to the subway

Reading the map

We are here at Waterloo Station. We want to be at Mayfair Station, so we need to take the yellow line and at the fourth stop, we need to get off and change to the blue line west. Then we travel for nine stops until we get to Victoria Station, get off, and change again to the green line. Then we need to travel to the end of the line, that's our destination.

Inside the train

There's an open seat. You can sit down, I will stand. Oh goodness, it's so crowded. Hold on to the handlebars.

Changing lines

We need to get off here and change to the green line. We should follow the arrows to our platform.

Traveling to the end destination

Seven stops to go. That's the last stop where we need to get off.

Arriving at destination

This is our stop, let's get off. There's the exit to High Street. Scan your ticket at the gate so that you can exit.
