Conversation between friends:

A: Bertie, when is your birthday?

B: It's **January, 5th**. When is yours?

A: **October, 23rd**.

B: My brother was born on **February, 29th**. Every leap year, his birthday changes to the **28th**.

A: Wow, that's crazy!

B: Which day of the week is your favorite?

A: I like Wednesdays. It's the **3rd** day of the week, so it cuts my week in half. I also don't work on Wednesdays, but I work on Saturdays. Every **2nd Saturday**, we do not have to work.

B: Oh okay. I like Fridays but dislike Sundays. A Friday is just before the weekend and I am always excited about that! I'm sad on a Sunday because I know it's back to work the next day.
