## Vocabulary

### Student A

1. How do you study and memorize new vocabulary?
2. How many English words do you know?
3. What is your favorite English word? A word that you like to use often.
4. Is there any word that you struggle to pronounce?
5. What else can English learners do to improve their vocabulary, besides memorizing it?
6. Do you think you have a good knowledge of vocabulary in your language?
7. Loanwords are words that we *borrow (use)* from another language. Does English have any loanwords from your language?
