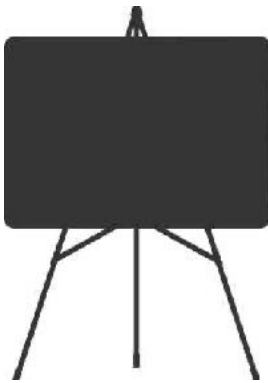


ADJECTIVES

Opposites

Activity 1 is a list of **adjectives**. Give each student an electronic copy, print a copy, or display the page on the projector. Try to elicit the opposite for each adjective. Try to get the students to use each adjective in a sentence using the verb **'to be'**. Otherwise, give an example sentence yourself. Use the pictures below of **'black and white'** to explain opposites, i.e. the rabbit is white with black and the cat is black. We get a whiteboard and a blackboard.
