Ask this question and write it on the board:

Write on the board:

'Where do you work?'

'I work at [SCHOOL'S NAME].'

Pair the students. Practice the above questions.

'Where do I work? I work at [COMPANY].'

'Where does he work? He works at [COMPANY].'

'Where does she work? She works at [COMPANY].'

The students need to swap roles.




