WHAT ARE YOU DOING?

1. What do you like doing?

Start to write the alphabet on the board and try to elicit the letters from the students as you go along. Write this sentence on the board:

'I'm [NAME] and I like [DOING SOMETHING].'

Under line the '-ing' in SOMETH<u>ING</u> and write just the suffix '-'-ing' in the top right corner of the board. I am Peter and I like swimming.

2. I like...

The infinitive form of a verb is written with the following formula:

'to + verb'. For example, 'to talk, 'to find' or 'to fight'.

We can also use the verb as a noun by adding the suffix 'ing'. For example, 'Running is fun'. In this sentence, 'running' is the gerund. Give Handout 1 electronically to each student, print it, or display it on a projector. The sentence is written in its infinitive form. The student needs to read the sentence as is and then change the verb into its gerund form by adding 'ing'. The teacher needs to correct pronunciation where applicable.

3. Pair-work. Give the students a few minutes to ask each other questions. They need to use the gerund form of the verb. Question: 'What's your name and what do you like doing in your free time?'

Answer: 'I'm [NAME], I like playing tennis.'
