Activity 1: The Back to School Game (Group Game)

One student mimes an action from the first day of school (e.g. putting books in the desk, greeting a friend, showing their new backpack).

The other students guess:

“Are you talking to your friend?” / “Are you showing your new bag?” etc.

Activity 2: Would You Rather...? (Discussion)

Discuss with your partner.

2. Would you rather have **lots of homework** or **lots of tests**?
3. Would you rather sit next to a **quiet student** or a **talkative student**?
