

FOOD AND BEVERAGE

1. Do you want a snack?


Ask the students 'Do you want a snack?' Point out the pronunciation of "snack" as students struggle with this pronounciation - it often comes out as 'snake!'. Let each student say the word, correct if needed.

Mary:	'Do you want a snack?'
Tom:	'Yes, please. I want a cookie.'

2. Practice

Pair the students. Give each student the handout electronically, print it, or display it on a projector. They can use the snacks on the handout to make conversation. This is also an exercise to recognize snacks in the pictures.

Students need to take turns asking questions and answering.




