YESTERDAY

Lesson Objectives

Introducing the simple past tense when we talk about yesterday.

Target Language

Present form of the verb vs the past form of the verb.

What did you do yesterday afternoon?

Yesterday, I worked at the store.

What did she do? She played tennis.

What did they do yesterday? They played soccer on the beach.

Talkmor suggestion:

Wave at your students. Make sure you have everyone's attention. Use your hands to point at yourself and say "hello". You can alternate, with "Hi".

Point at yourself and say:

'I'm teacher [NAME]. What's your name and how are you today?'

Prompt the answer:

'I am good, thank you. How are you?' (Smile)

'I am fine, thank you, and you?' (Smile)

I'm not so good, but how are you?' (Frown)

If the answer is negative, you can say:

'I'm sorry to hear that, what is wrong?'

Listen to their pronunciation when they repeat the word. Go to each one and listen carefully. Help and correct the pronunciation.
