WHAT DO YOU DO EVERY DAY?

TEACHER-STUDENT WORKSHEET

1. When Do You?

Write a list of times on the board and elicit common actions at each time.

Example:

7.00 AM - get up 2 PM - visit a customer

8.00 AM - eat breakfast
9.00 AM - go to work
10.00 AM - have a meeting
12.00 PM - eat lunch
5 PM - go home
6 PM - eat dinner
8 PM - watch TV
10 PM - go to bed

Introduce the new vocabulary such as the meals of the day, and common activities that we do during the day and evening.

Conversation 1: Point at a student.

Question: 'When do you eat breakfast?'

Answer: 'I eat breakfast at a quarter to eight.'

Conversation 2: Point at the first student but ask the question to another:

Question: 'When does he eat breakfast?'

Answer: 'He eats breakfast at a quarter to

eight.'

Use the third person questioning pattern and ask questions to all students. Make sure the students answer in full sentences.
