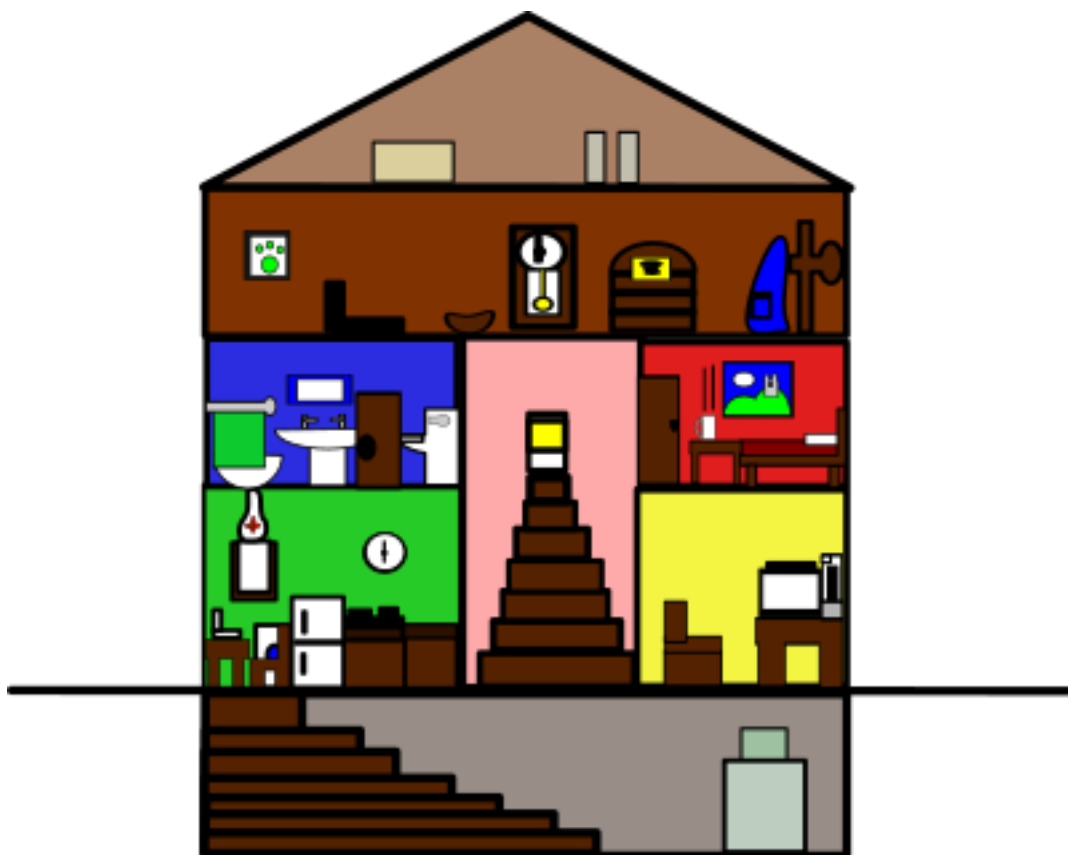


Main - Activity 1

TEACHER-STUDENT WORKSHEET. ELICIT THE ANSWERS AND WRITE THEM ON THE BOARD

1. Elicit from students what rooms we get in a house.
Write the answers on the board. Elicit what we do in those rooms.

2. What do we do in each room?

Students now know what rooms we get in a house. Look at the grid and match the activities with the rooms in the house.

Room in the house	What we do in the room
Balcony	People sleep here.
Bathroom	People study or work in this room.
Living Room	People park their car here.
Kitchen	People sit and watch TV here.
Study	People shower or bathe here.
Dining Room	People have flowers and plants here.
Garage	People sit around a table and eat here.
Bedroom	People cook in this room.

3. Match the word with its definition.

Example: A window is made of glass and we can look through it.

Object	Description
Floor	It is something that you use to walk up to the next floor.
Ceiling	It divides two rooms.
Door	It's on top of the house.
Stairs	It's the entrance to a room.
Roof	It's above your head.
