WHERE IS IT?

1. Locations

Elicit locations on a map:

‘next to, behind, in front of, across from, on Main Street, on the corner of, between, opposite, on top of, below, underneath, in the middle of, on the second floor, on the top floor, on the bottom floor’

Give each student **Handout 1**.

Students are going to describe where a building is by using ‘prepositions of place.’

Write on the board:

Question: ‘Where is [NOUN]?’

Answer: ‘It is behind, between, etc.’

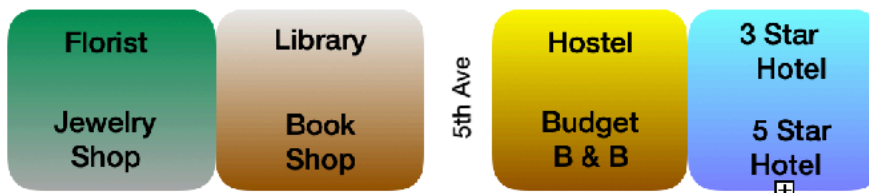
Use prepositions of place and tell your partner where the place is on the map

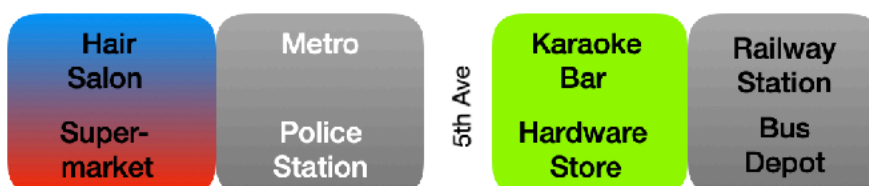
Church Street
