TEACHER WORKSHEET AND STUDENT HANDOUTS. ELICIT ANSWERS AND WRITE THEM ON THE BOARD

1. My Home Town

Question: 'Is there a [PLACE] in your town?'

Divide the students into A and B groups with 4 people in each group. There are 4 Town Maps in **Handout 2**. Give each person in Group A, a Town Plan.

Give the Questionnaire, and **Handout 1** to each student in Group B. Work through the vocabulary with the students.

Give the 'A's' a little time to study their plans and invent a name for their towns and 'B's' a little time to look at their questionnaires.

Ask the 'A- groups' for the names of their towns.

Tell the 'A-groups' that the 'B-groups' are looking for a town to live in. The 'B-groups' need to find a place where they would like to live in.

The 'B-groups need to move to each 'town' and ask the townspeople ('A-groups') questions about their towns. Use the above conversation to ask the questions.

The 'B-groups' decide amongst themselves which town they prefer and why. Tell the teacher.


