WHERE IS IT?

1. North, East, West, South

Give each **Handout 1**.

Show NESW and the basic divisions of NE, SW, NW, and SE.

Give each student **Handout 2**.

The students have a blank compass. Give them five minutes to complete the drawing with the correct directions.

Give each student **Handout 3** which is a map of the USA.

Students practice in pairs how to tell the location of a place by using the compass.

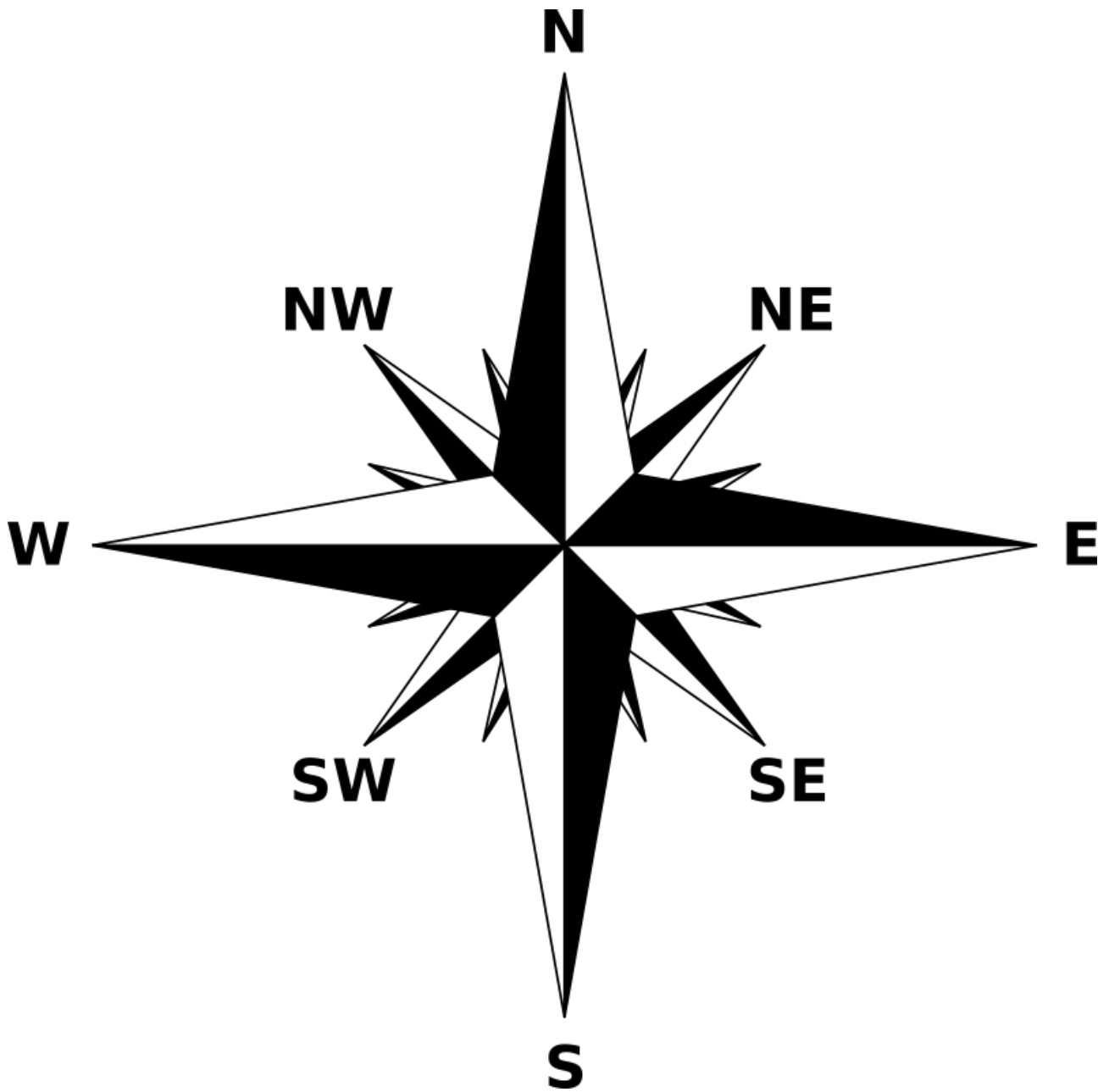
The format below is to be practiced:

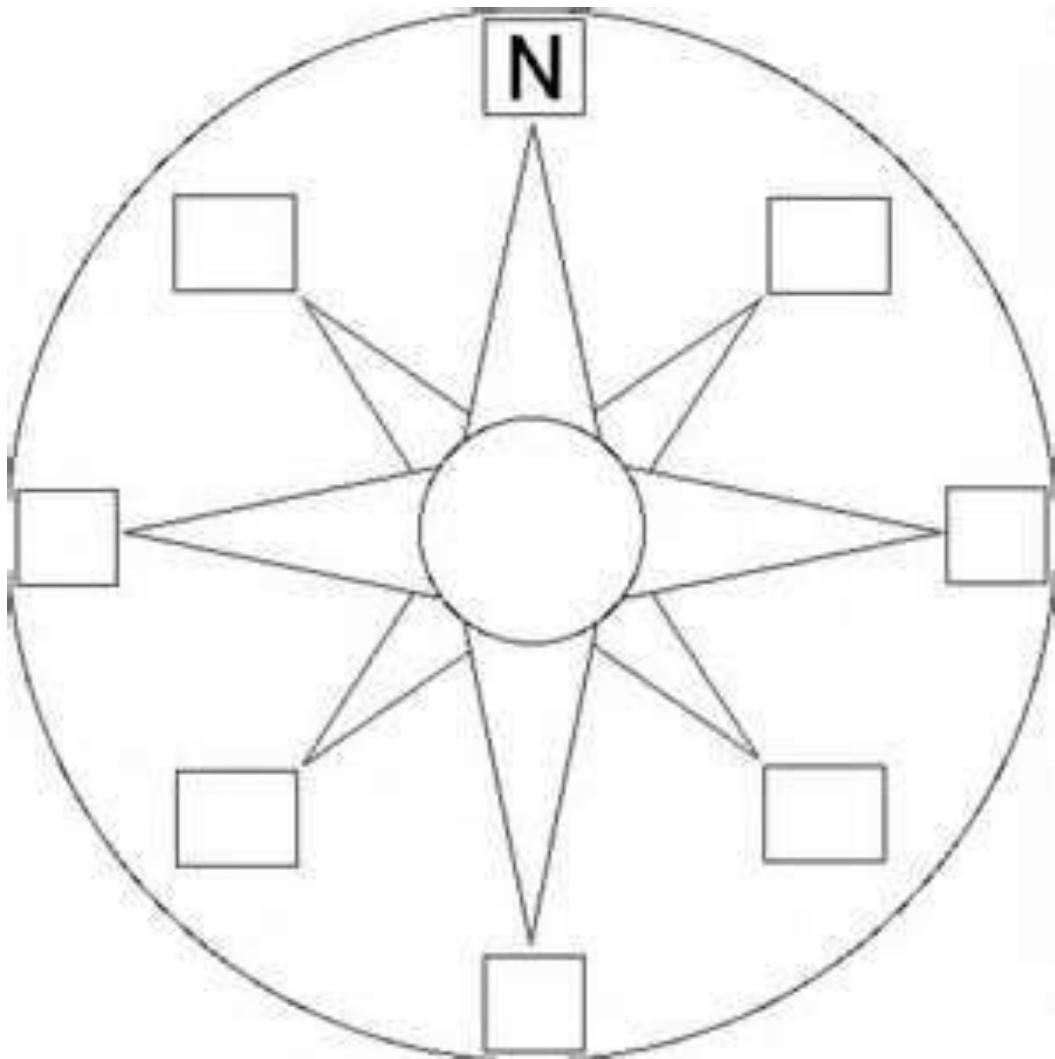
Learn the directions on a compass

In pairs, tell your partner where a city or a state is in the USA, using the compass. The city's name is in smaller writing and next to the black star, i.e. look in the middle of the map, the state of Kansas (yellow) and its capital city which is Topeka. Keep the sentences simple.

Example: 'Where is South Dakota?'

'It is north of Nebraska.'

'Where is Atlanta?'

'It is south-east of Nashville.'
