1. A Treasure Hunt

Pair-work

Vocabulary:

‘turn, walk along, walk around, pass, exit, go through, on your right, on your left, stop, in front of, look under, between.’

Look at the map below. Each of you will receive a list of clues. You need to read the clue in number order to each other and practice the directions.

Find the treasure and answer the remaining questions.

Directions to find the treasure. Take turns to read your clues in number order to your partner.

Student A - clues

1.	Go to the parking lot and look at the park.
3.	Walk around the building and go to the museum.
5.	After you have eaten, turn around and walk back to the museum. Turn left at the WC and walk along the footpath until you get to the two big animals on your right.
7.	When you exit the WC, turn right until you get to the main footpath where the two animals are. Turn left.
9.	Exit the tunnel and go to the WC. Turn left onto the small footpath and walk to the fourth tree on your left. Turn right.
11.	Look under the rock, the treasure is there!
13.	How many palm trees are there in the park? Where are they?

Student B - clues

2.	Enter the park and turn right to buy a ticket at the ticket office.
4.	Visit the museum and when you exit, walk straight to the food stalls in front of you and buy something to eat.
6.	Turn left and go to the WC.
8.	Walk along the footpath, pass the Orangery and go to the mountain. Walk through the tunnel.
10.	Walk straight to the sixth tree. Stop and turn right again. Walk between the smallest dinosaur and the volcano. In front of you is a small rock.
12.	What is another word for 'WC'?
14.	Where are the six table and benches where we can eat? _____ of the food stalls?
