1. Pair-work: Students practice the two conversations below:

Example: **Present Progressive Tense (action is happening now)**

Question: 'What is the girl doing?'

Answer: 'She is dancing.'

Example: **Past tense**

Question: 'What did the man do?'

Answer: 'He painted a picture.'

Use picture 1 to practice the action **now** and picture 2 to practice the action **yesterday**.



Picture 1

Pair-work: One student points at a person(s) in the picture.

Take turns.

Use the Present Progressive Tense (The action is happening now).

Question: 'What is the girl doing?'

Answer: 'She is walking with the dog.'



Picture 2

Pair-work: One student points at a person(s) in the picture.
Take turns.

Use the past tense.

Example: 'What did the baby do?'
'He jumped up and down on the bench.'
