Always and Never

3 students in a group. Student A asks Student B. Student A tells the group what Student B said. Student B asks Student C and reports to the group what Student C said. Student C asks Student A and reports to the group what Student A said. Each student will use the third person to report to the group what the other student had said.

1. Student A asks Student B. Student A then tells Student C what Student B said. Student A needs to use 'he/she' in his/her retelling.
 1. 'What always makes you smile?'
 2. 'What always makes you frown?'
 3. 'What always makes you laugh?'
 4. 'What do you usually do on a Saturday?'

2. Student B asks Student C. Student B then tells Student A what Student C said. Student B needs to use 'he/she' in his/her retelling.

1. 'What always makes you cry?'
2. 'What always makes you angry?'
3. 'What always makes you unhappy?'
4. 'Is there something you never do?'

3. Student C asks Student A. Student C then tells Student B what Student A said. Student C needs to use 'he/she' in his/her retelling.

1. 'What always makes you lazy?'
2. 'What always makes you hungry?'
3. 'What always makes you sleepy?'
4. On which day of the week do you do absolutely nothing?'
