

ADVERBS

What is an adverb?

Adverbs describe a verb, adjective, or another adverb. It tells us how, where, when, how much, and with what frequency something is done. **These worksheets will look at a few *adverbs of manner* and *adverbs of frequency*.**

1. Adverbs of manner:

softly
high

loudly
low

slowly
quietly

quickly
hard

Example Sentences:

She speaks **softly**.

Grandpa walks **slowly**.

Please jump **high**.

You need to move **quietly**.

The children screamed **loudly** for their team.

You need to run **quickly**.

Please crawl **low**.

I study **hard**.

2. Adverbs of frequency:

These words tell us **how frequently** we do things or **how frequently** things happen.

Adverb	Percentage (How often)	Example Sentence
Always	100%	I always drink a glass of milk for breakfast.
Usually	80%	I usually go to bed at 10 p.m.
Often	70%	My sister often takes our dog for a walk.
Sometimes	40%	Peter sometimes helps me with my homework.
Hardly ever	20%	I hardly ever watch scary movies.
Never	0%	I never eat junk food because it is bad for my health.
