

FRIENDSHIP AND CLOTHING

TEACHER WORKSHEET AND STUDENT HANDOUT

1. Give the students **Handout 1.**

There are three faces. The middle face is 'me'. At the top is 'Nina' and at the bottom is 'Andy.'

Point to 'me' and say:

'This is me.'

Point to Nina and say:

'This is Nina, she is my best friend.'

Point to Andy and say:

'This is Andy, he is my friend.'

Introduce the sentences:

'Who is your best friend?'

'[NOUN] is my best friend.'

- Put the students in groups of 4. Allow each one to introduce two friends out of the group to the rest of the group.
 Each student needs to get the opportunity to make introductions.
- 3. Pair work. Students ask each other 'Who is your best friend?'
 This answer can be a person out of real life. The partner needs to answer and swap roles.
