# **TEACHER WORKSHEET**

### 1. How does the snake move?

If you have children in the class, let them form a snake (stand behind each other with their hands on the shoulders of the person in front). The teacher stands in front of the class and demonstrates the movement and the word.

## Words to practice:

quick+ly = quickly	slow+ly = slowly
high = high	low = low
soft+ly = softly	loud+ly = loudly
quiet+ly = quietly	hard = hard

The students will move forward by shouting the word and moving according to the word, i.e. quickly means they will move quickly, etc.



#### **TEACHER WORKSHEET**

#### Instructions for this activity

Each student puts his/her hands on the shoulders of the person in front of him/her. Look at the teacher and follow his/her gestures and repeat the word he/she says. Each step indicates a new word and movement.

#### Step One - 'ssssss'

Move forward like a snake and say 'ssssss' whilst you move. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step Two - 'quickly'

Move forward like a snake and say 'quickly, quickly, quickly' whilst you move quickly. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step Three - 'slowly'

Move forward like a snake and say 'slowly, slowly, slowly' whilst you move slowly. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step four - 'high'

Move forward like a snake and say 'high, high, high' whilst you lift your arms in the air. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step five - 'low'

Move forward like a snake and say 'low, low, low' whilst you drop your arms low as well as your head. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step six - ' hard'

Move forward like a snake and say 'hard, hard, hard' whilst you stamp hard with your feet on the ground. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step seven - 'quietly'

Move forward like a snake and say 'quietly, quietly, quietly' whilst you tip-toe on the ground. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!

#### Step eight - 'loudly'

Move forward like a snake and shout 'loudly, loudly, loudly' whilst you move forward. Stop when the teacher shouts 'stop'!
