

# WARM-UP

## WILD ANIMALS

### TEACHER WORKSHEET

#### 1. Introducing wild animals

Bring some farm animal plastic toys to the class or get pictures. Introduce each animal's name:

'This is a lion.'

Introduce each animal. You can make the sound of the animal if you like. Let the students repeat your sentence. 'This is a lion.'

#### 2. Give the students **Handout 1**. These are pictures of wild animals.

Point at the lion and practice the sentences:

Teacher: 'This is a lion'

Students: 'This is a lion'

Teacher: 'roar, roar'

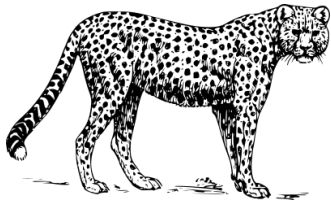
Students: 'roar, roar'

Ask the students to point at the lion on **Handout 1**. See whether they can find it. Ask:

Teacher: 'Is this a lion?'

Students: 'Yes, this is a lion.'

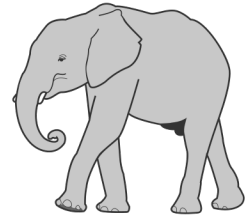

## WORKSHEET

### 3. Show **Handout 1**.

Say the name of an animal, and the students need to quickly point at the picture of that animal. They also need to repeat the name of the animal when they point at the picture.

Cover one picture and ask the students which animal is missing.

Teacher: 'Which animal is missing?'

Students: 'The lion is missing, etc.'

Continue covering the pictures, one at a time, until no animals are left. See whether the students can remember the animals that are missing.

### 4. **Complete the name of the animal**

Give the students **Handout 2** with the missing animal names.

Ask the students to compete who can fill the gaps the quickest.

### 5. **Guess the animal**

The teacher or a student imitates an animal. The rest of the class should guess what animal it is. This is a fun activity.

Improvise!

- *lion: look scary and roars*
- *elephant: make yourself big, make a trunk with your arm and make the trumpet noise*
- *monkey: do the monkey scratching head and armpit gesture whilst saying "ooh-ooh"*
- *tiger: look fierce and roars*
- *leopard: pretend to run very fast*
- *kangaroo: hold your hands in front of your face and jump*
- *wolf: look around and howl*
