## ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

#### TEACHER-STUDENT WORKSHEET

#### 1. Days of the week

Make a little ball out of paper and throw it at the students. Whoever catches the ball, needs to say 'Monday'. The next student says 'Tuesday', etc. Continue with the days of the week. If someone drops the ball or says the wrong word, then he/she has to start with 'Monday' again! Do this for two rounds.

#### 2. Which day of the week is the best?

Write on the board: 'The best day of the week is [DAY].' Elicit from the students which day they like the most. Let them vote and write the winning day on the board.

'The best day of the week is a Saturday.'

Ask the students why they chose this day.

'The best day of the week is a Saturday because...

### 3. Introduce the adverbs of frequency

Go over the entries below and bring the adverbs of frequency to the attention of the students.

I chat to my friends.	I don't have to work.	Often	60%

1.	On Saturdays, I always sleep late.	100%
2.	On Saturdays, I usually sleep late	80%
3.	On Saturdays, I often sleep late	60%

5.	On Saturdays, I hardly ever sleep late	20%
6.	On Saturdays, I never sleep late	0%

#### Practice the conversation with the students:

Sally: 'I never sleep late on a Saturday.'

Mary: 'How often do you sleep late on a Saturday?'

Rick: 'I always sleep late on a Saturday.'

#### **STUDENT HANDOUT**

Take turns to be Student A and Student B.
