

QUANTIFIERS & DIRECTIONS

Words that you should be familiar with and know how to use it in a sentence.

some	any	a little	a lot
lots	little	turn	walk along
walk round	pass	exit	enter
go through	on your right	on your left	stop
in front of	under	between	go straight

Example Sentences:

1. Do you have *any* milk?
2. Yes, there is *some* in the refrigerator.
3. Would you like *some* Coca-Cola?
4. A *little* bit, thank you.
5. The dam has *lots* of water in it.
6. Wow, you have *a lot* of pens!
7. Please help yourself, there are *lots* of different drinks to choose from!
8. I have *little* money; it will not be possible to go traveling!
9. *Enter* the building, then *turn right*. You will find Betty's office *on your left*.
10. *Walk straight*, you will come to a *stop*. *Turn left*, and *walk along* the river until you find the restaurant *in front of* you.
11. You need to *exit* the building at number 2. It is *between* McDonald's and KFC.
12. Look *under* your chair. Your bag is there.
