

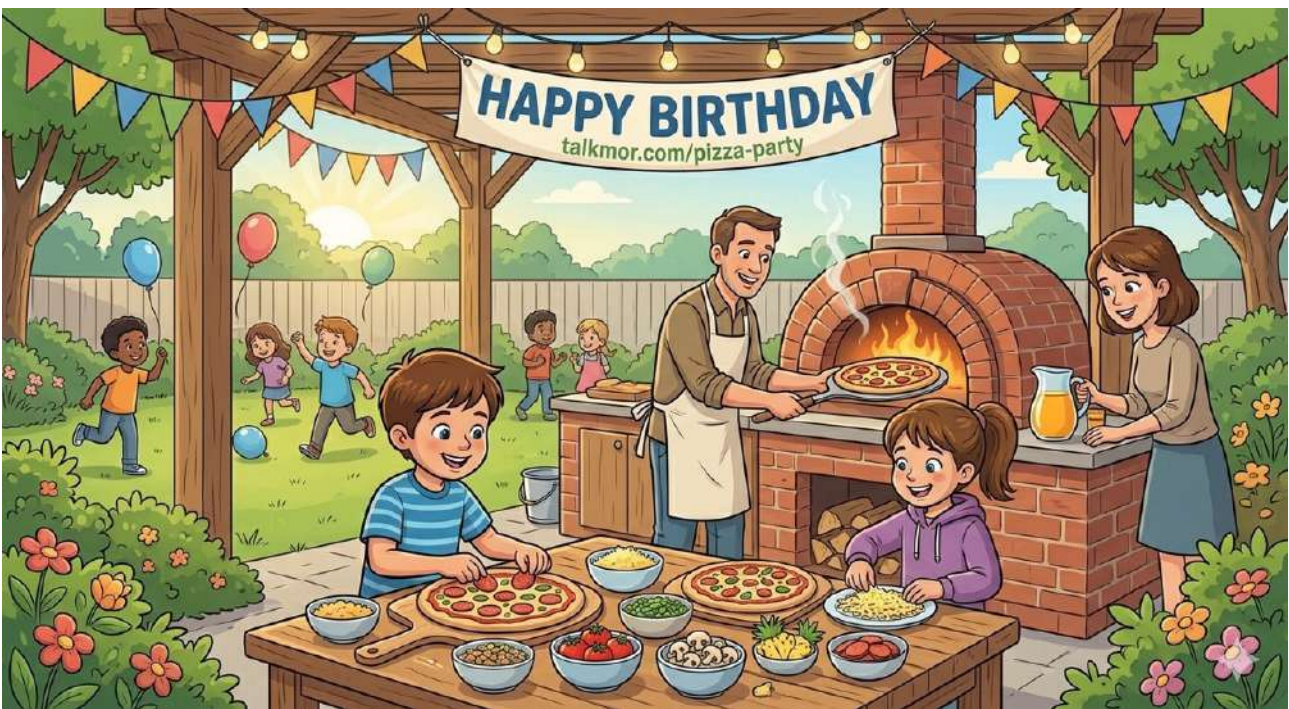


## PIZZA PARTY!
