

EVENTS MONTHS & DATES

Lesson Objectives

This lesson introduces events and their dates

Target Language

My mother's birthday is on May, 13. We have Halloween Festival on October, 31. Our family get together on Christmas Day which is on December, 25. My Mom and Dad got married on September, 20. My first child was born on August 2. The party starts at 8 o'clock. My sister's birthday is in April.

Talkmor suggestion:

Wave at your students. Make sure you have everyone's attention. Use your hands to point at yourself and say "hello". You can alternate, with "Hi" or "Good morning", "Good afternoon", or "Good evening".

Look at a student and ask a question:

"How are you today?" "How was your day?"

"Did you sleep well last night?"

Prompt the answer:

"I'm good, thank you teacher, and you?" (Smile)

"My day was good." (Smile)

"Yes, thank you teacher, and you?" (Smile)

If the answer is negative, you can say:

'I'm sorry to hear that, what is wrong?'

Listen to their pronunciation when they repeat the word. Go to each one and listen carefully. Help and correct the pronunciation.
