### Teacher's Guide

#### Objectives (Can-Do Statements)

- I can name and describe fast food and restaurant items.
- I can use countable/uncountable nouns and some/any.
- I can ask and answer questions about food and preferences.
- I can order food in a simple restaurant situation.

### Warm-up Questions (Teacher-Student – 5–8 minutes)

Great way to start — ask these orally before showing the big picture:

1. Do you know any fast food words in English?
2. Do you like burgers? Why or why not?
3. What is your favorite fast food?
4. How often do you eat fast food? (once a week, never, every weekend...)
5. What do you usually put on your burger?
6. Do you prefer eating at home or in a restaurant? Why?
7. What is a popular fast food in your country?
8. We are going to look at a picture of a restaurant. What food do you think we will see?

#### Vocabulary Elicitation:

- Let's make a word list on the board. Tell me all the food words you know.
- Then show the big central image and move to the picture-based activities.

**Tip:** Accept short answers at A1, push for longer sentences at A2.
