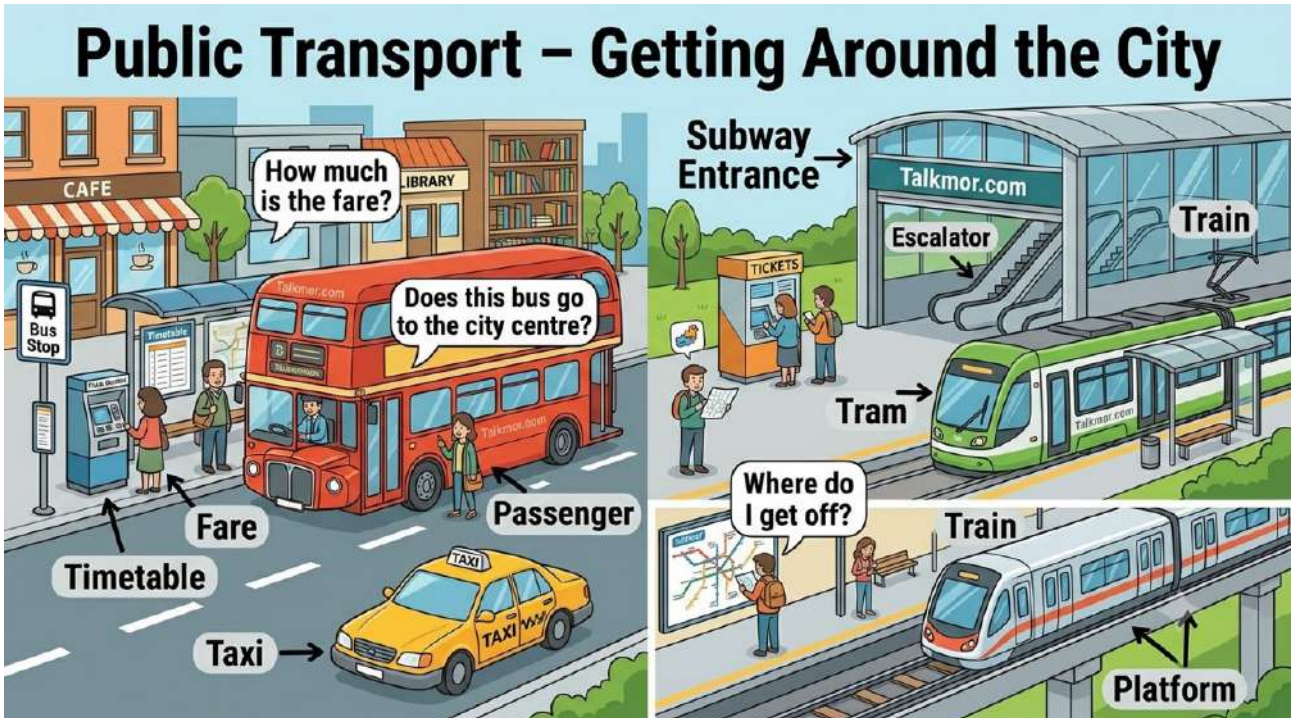




## PUBLIC TRANSPORT – GETTING AROUND THE CITY
