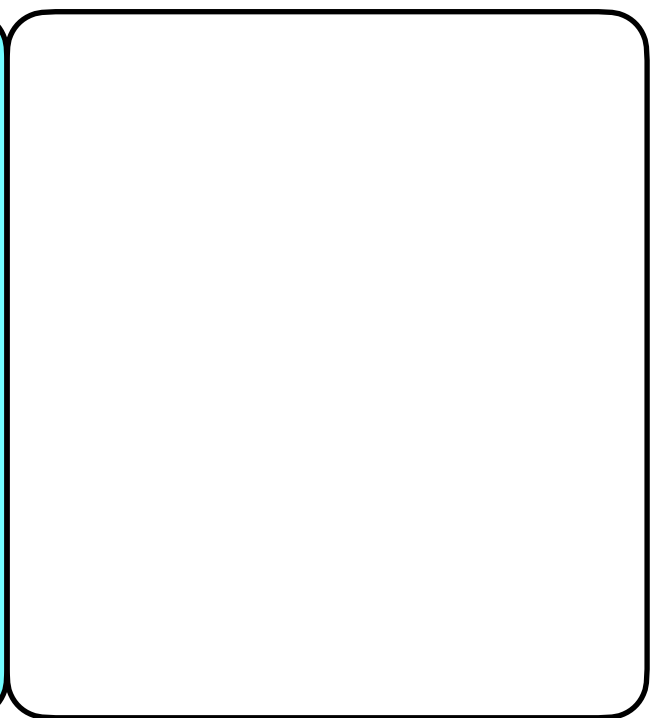
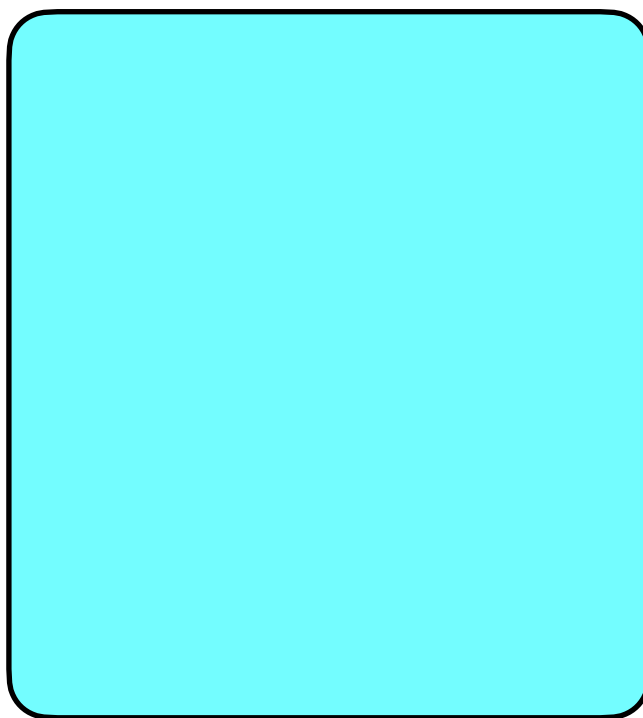
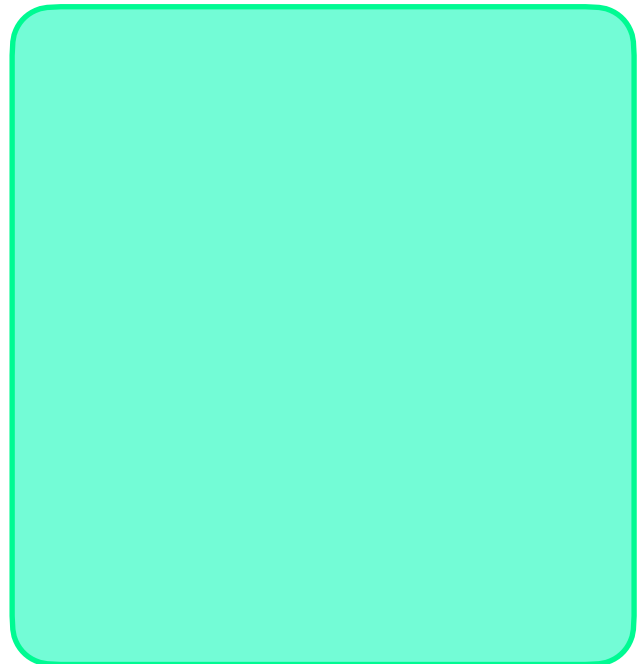
Homework
