## NATIONALITY

### Lesson Objectives

Students practice asking questions about nationalities.

### Target Language

Where are you from? I am from Italy. I'm Italian.

Where do you come from? I live in Italy. I speak Italian.

### Vocabulary

Country Adjective Noun

Australia Australian an Australian Etc.

The word **Nationality** is mostly used in the travel industry and for immigration.

**We seldom say:** What is your nationality?

**We usually say:** *Where are you from* or *where do you come from?*

To answer the question you don't say: My nationality is American.

You say: I'm American.

### **Talkmor suggestion:**

If you have a student from a different country introduce him/her:

This is Farah, she is from Libia, she is a Libian.

If you don't have any foreign students, just have fun and introduce some students as Japanese or Spanish, or Polish... just be careful not to insult anyone.
