### Exploring Our Body!

#### Word Library

Here are some important words about our external body parts. Read them and try to remember what they mean.

- **Finger:** One of the five long parts at the end of your hand.
- **Thumb:** The short, thick finger on your hand.
- **Palm:** The inside part of your hand.
- **Wrist:** The part that connects your hand to your arm.
- **Elbow:** The joint in the middle of your arm that lets it bend.
- **Shoulder:** The part of your body where your arm joins your body.
- **Ankle:** The joint that connects your foot to your leg.
- **Neck:** The part of your body that connects your head to your shoulders.
- **Chin:** The bottom part of your face, below your mouth.
- **Cheek:** The side part of your face below your eyes.
- **Forehead:** The part of your face above your eyes and below your hair.

Body Part	Description
