Mrs. (Missus) - when addressing a married woman.

Ms (Miz) - when you are not sure of a woman's marital status.

Miss - when addressing girls and young, unmarried women.

Dr. - when you are addressing a person with a doctoral degree.

Professor - in a university setting.
