Lesson Objectives

Students learn words that they should be familiar with and know how to use in a sentence.

Students write sentences about spending money, etc.

Practice how to say prices in English?

Target Language

In America, they use dollars. In Europe, they use euros.

€5.50 - Five fifty.

€545.50 = five hundred and forty-five euros and 50 cents.

I have two bank accounts.

My mother only *pays* by *credit card*.

I usually make *electronic payments*.

I always have a problem with my budget. Etc.

Vocabulary

account, balance, income, save, deposit, salary, currency, exchange, barter, afford, bargain, budget, expensive, withdraw, note, cash, cashier, dollar, euro, yuan, pound, wallet, receipt, credit card, etc.

Talkmor Suggestion:

Do your students know how to say prices in English?

The easiest, and most useful way, is to say the first number (before the period/full stop) and then the second number (the "cents" after the full stop).
