Lesson Objectives

Students learn words that they should be familiar with and know how to use in a sentence.

Students write sentences about spending money, etc.

Practice how to say prices in English?

Target Language

In America, they use dollars. In Europe, they use euros.

€5.50 - Five fifty.

€545.50 = five hundred and forty-five euros and 50 cents.

I have two bank **accounts**.

My mother only **pays** by **credit card**.

I usually make **electronic payments**.

I always have a problem with my **budget**. Etc.

Vocabulary

account, balance, income, save, deposit, salary, currency, exchange, barter, afford, bargain, budget, expensive, withdraw, note, cash, cashier, dollar, euro, yuan, pound, wallet, receipt, credit card, etc.

Talkmor Suggestion:

Do your students know how to say prices in English?

The easiest, and most useful way, is to say the first number (before the period/full stop) and then the second number (the “cents” after the full stop).
