VOCAB FUN 2

1. Ask Ss to close their books.
2. Tell students to think of **Color** and any word related to **Color** that comes to their minds, e.g. what color comes to mind when we think of a beverage? **Black** - **black** coffee, Coke-cola, etc.
3. In a small class, ask each student in a round-robin manner.
4. In a big class, students can be divided into teams.
5. Students must listen carefully and can NOT repeat any words.
6. The first round is easy, but then students start to run out of words.
7. This should be a fun activity. Keep going a few rounds.
8. You can allow students to use their dictionaries if you wish. Write the good words on the board.

If students enjoy the activity, do the same with the following words:

Disaster	Sport
Dating	University
Western food	Working holiday
