VOLUNTEER WORK

Volunteer Work *Outside* Your Country.

Your teacher will tell you whether they want you to do a two, three, or five-minute oral presentation for the next class.

You **may not** talk about volunteer work in your country.

You **may not** talk about teaching English in another country.

There are some expensive volunteer jobs you can do in most countries, especially jobs where you work with animals. There is also some less expensive volunteer work, like working with kids and other community work, and then there are free volunteer jobs where you only have to get there at your own cost. The host will supply a place to sleep and one, two, or three meals daily.

Developing countries need volunteer workers throughout the year and there are a variety of projects to choose from. If you would like to do volunteer work in Costa Rica for example, just research “volunteer jobs in Costa Rica” and you will be surprised at how many different jobs there are.

Research the following about the country you want to do volunteer work:

Return airfare. (Find the cheapest ticket)

The weather.

Description of the volunteer work. What kind of work you will do.

What the host offers. (Like accommodation, meals, and entertainment)

The minimum time you should spend there.

How many people you will be working with.

Enjoy the research. See you next time.
