Lesson Objectives

Students practice using Possessive Pronouns as the subject of a sentence to avoid unnecessary repeating of information.

Target Language

This book is **mine**. That bag is **his**. The pen is **hers**. The cookies are **yours**. These pictures are **ours**, etc.

Male	- His	Female	- hers		
1st Person	- Mine	2nd Person	- yours	3rd Person	- his its



Possessive pronouns are a type of pronoun [a word that replaces a noun] that indicate possession - they tell us to whom something belongs.
