Students practice using Possessive Pronouns as the subject of a sentence to avoid unnecessary repeating of information.

Target Language

This book is *mine*. That bag is *his*. The pen is *hers*. The cookies are *yours*. These pictures are *ours*, etc.

Possessive pronouns are a type of pronoun [a word that replaces a noun] that indicate possession - they tell us to whom something belongs.
