Explain to your students that verbs are "doing" words i.e. sleep, run, eat, and that every sentence needs at least one verb.

Underline the verb "to be" in the above answers and explain that they are the verbs "to be".

Pronoun

A pronoun is a word that can replace a noun in a sentence.

Pronouns can do all of the things that nouns can do. They can be subjects, direct objects, indirect objects, objects of the preposition, etc.

Contraction

A contraction is when two words are shortened and are put together to form one new word i.e. I and am can be combined to create a shorter word, I'm.

Positive and Negative

A positive sentence [affirmative] means something **is so**, while a negative sentence means something **is not so**.

Present

Pronoun	Positive	Negative
I	l am - l'm	I am not - I'm not
You	You are - you're	You are not - you aren't
He	He is - he's	He is not - he isn't
She	She is - she's	She is not - she isn't
It	It is - it's	It is not - it isn't
We	We are - we're	We are not - we aren't
They	They are - they're	They are not - they aren't
You	You are - you're	You are not - you aren't

Past: Was / Were

Pronoun	Positive	Negative
I	I was	I was - I wasn't
You	You were	You were - You weren't
He	He was	He was - He wasn't
She	She was	She was - She wasn't
It	It was	It was - It wasn't
We	We were	We were - We weren't
They	They were	They were - They weren't
You	You were	You were - You weren't
