Vocabulary

Before, after that, first, second, then, next, now, and finally.

Mouthwash, toothpaste, mirror, toothbrush holder, medicine cupboard, basin, mirror cupboard, floss, toothbrush.

There are benefits to flossing first. It's like sweeping a floor before you mop it. If you floss first, you get rid of any pieces of food stuck between your teeth and the toothbrush can clean everywhere and your toothpaste can get into all the small gaps [places].
