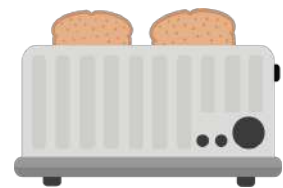




HOW TO BRUSH YOUR TEETH

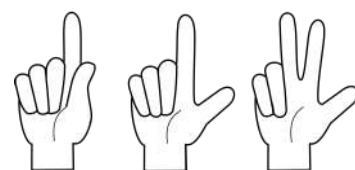
Sequence words we can use when we give instructions.
