9. \_\_\_\_\_ put enough toothpaste on your toothbrush [not too much].

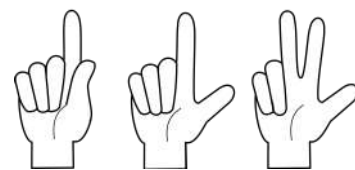
#### Sequence words we can use when we give instructions.
