Lesson Objectives

Introducing common TV programs and schedules

Target Language

I always watch TV on a Wednesday night. My favorite program is the news. Saturday evenings I watch a music show and the history channel is also interesting. I usually watch TV from 7 o'clock until eleven o'clock over weekends. I never watch game shows!

Talkmor suggestion:

Wave at your students. Make sure you have everyone's attention. Greet everyone by saying "Good morning, good afternoon or Good evening".

Make an effort to ask each student an easy question (depending on the number of students).

"How are you today?" (Smile)

"Did you sleep well last night?" (Smile)

"What did you have for breakfast?" (Smile)

Prompt the answer:

'I am good, thank you. How are you?' (Smile)

'I slept well, and you?" (Smile)

"I had eggs, bread, and coffee" or "I ate eggs, bread, and drank coffee".

Listen to their pronunciation when they repeat the word. Go to each one and listen carefully. Help and correct the pronunciation.
