NAME IT

Your teacher will read one letter from the alphabet.

You have to think of a name/word for each of the 6 columns.

You have 2 minutes to do this. If you finish before 2 min, you must shout STOP!

When any student shouts STOP, all persons should stop writing.

The first line is an example of the letter “W”.

You can earn a bonus point if you can name a Country and an International City.

You get 2 points if your answer is correct and no one else has the same answer.

You get one point if someone has the same answer and zero for no answer.
