

Questions With The Verb "Be"

Students practice using full sentences to ask and answer questions.

Target Language

Do you like...? [Eng, Europe, dogs, singing, winter, chocolate cake, etc]
Do you like to...? [go swimming, drink beer, wake up in the morning, etc]
Do you take...? [the subway, train, bus, medicine, extra classes, etc]

My name is Anthony. **Question**: What is your name? Etc.

Yes/No questions allow parents and teachers to offer choices, and children to have more control over their lives by giving a clear yes or no answer.
