Lesson Objectives

Students practice talking about what they see next to the road, asking directions, giving directions and talking about places in a city.

Target Language

Questions about places in a city, asking for directions and giving directions.

Where can I find a...?

In front of the...

There is one on Main Street.

To the left of...

Across from...

On Main Street, next to the...

On the corner of Church and Main Street.

Vocabulary

Fence, ATM, garage, shop, park, car park, cafe, fountain, fire hydrant, bridge, tower, food stall, street vendor, street lights, road signs, pedestrian crossing, traffic light, bench, bus stop, bin and intersection.

The **“Street Map - Where Am I?”** worksheet is a great activity to get students talking in pairs or small groups about their city. Let them complete the quiz on page 2 and discuss it at the same time. *(30-45 minutes)*
