

## DAYS & TIME

### 1. Days of the Week

Try to elicit the days of the week from the students.

Write the weekdays on the board with Monday on the left across to Sunday on the right.

Then say this:

‘Tuesday comes after Monday.’ Indicate on the board.

‘Wednesday comes before Thursday.’ Indicate on the board.

‘Friday comes between Thursday and Saturday.’ Indicate on the board.

Show several other examples.

Write this on the board:

‘[DAY] comes before/after between [DAY].’

**The above is the answer format for the students to use.**

**Give each student Handout 1.**

2. Draw a line from Monday to Friday and write underneath these days:

'Weekdays'.

Write this sentence on the board:

'I work on weekdays.' (Mondays to Fridays).

Draw a line from Saturday to Sunday and write underneath:

'weekend'.

Write this sentence on the board:

'I relax on weekends'.

Ask the students these questions:

(Elicit or build a full sentence answer for each)

1. 'Which two days are on the weekend?'
2. 'On which days do you work?'
3. 'How many days are there in a week?'
4. 'How many days are there in this month?'

Write on the board and elicit the answers:

Question: 'How many days of the week are there?'

Answer: 'There are five days in the week.'

Question: 'How many days are there on a weekend?'

Answer: 'There are two days on a weekend.'

Give the students **Handout 2** and let them write the answers and ask their partners. Take turns to ask the questions.
