



## DAYS & TIME

## 1. **Ago**

Ask the students what day is it today.

Ask the students what the other days of the week are and write them on the board in the correct order.

Then say and write this:

'Two days ago it was [DAY].'

Show the steps backward from today to the day two days ago. Make sure that they understand that we use ago when we talk about the past. Underline the word <u>AGO</u>.

Give **Handout 1** to each student. Go through the questions and answers together.
