

DAYS & TIME

1. Number challenge

Write the days of the week on the board. Above each day, write the number applicable: 'Monday, 1, Tuesday, 2, etc.'

Also write:

- 1 - first
- 2 - second
- 3 - third
- 4 - fourth
- 5 - fifth
- 6 - sixth
- 7 - seventh

Introduce the sentence and write on the board:

Monday is day 1

Monday is the first day of the week

Tuesday is day 2

Tuesday is the second day of the week

Sunday is day 7

Sunday is the seventh day of the week

The teacher points at a number on the board. Ask each student to give the above sentences to you.



2. Time Challenge

Print **Handout 1** and give the students a copy. Students need to ask and answer in the following format:

Pair-work. One student asks his/her partner:

Question: 'What time is this?'

Answer: 'It is two-fifteen or a quarter past two.'



Handout 1

Draw the hands in your clock. Use different times. Ask the question: **'What time is it?'** Answer: **'It is half past two or two-thirty.'**
