#### 1. Number challenge

Write the days of the week on the board. Above each day, write the number applicable: 'Monday, 1, Tuesday, 2, etc.'

Also write:

- 1 first
- 2 second
- 3 third
- 4 fourth
- 5 fifth
- 6 sixth
- 7 seventh

Introduce the sentence and write on the board:

Monday is day 1 Monday is the first day of the week Tuesday is day 2 Tuesday is the second day of the week Sunday is day 7 Sunday is the seventh day of the week

The teacher points at a number on the board. Ask each student to give the above sentences to you.



#### 2. Time Challenge

Print **Handout 1** and give the students a copy. Students need to ask and answer in the following format:


- Question: 'What time is this?'
